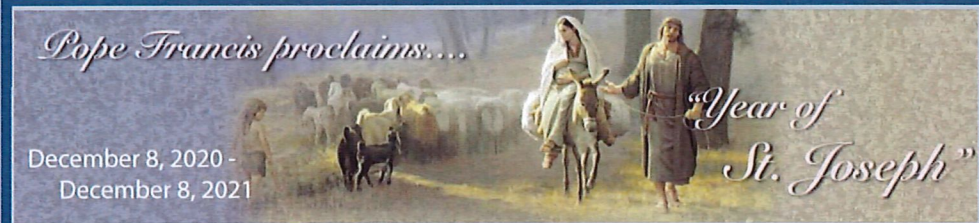

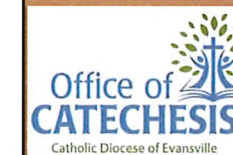
Coffee and Fellowship after Sunday 10 am Mass is returning soon. Volunteers are needed.
