

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL MINISTRY

This week we had a full schedule of 15 referrals. We had 3 water bill and 3 CenterPoint assistance requests. The rest were for vouchers to spend at the Thrift

Store for furniture items, or for rent assistance. Sometimes our members are exposed to such difficult situations that it is impossible not to be moved to tears. Two of our members visited a 20 year-old mother of a seriously autistic 3 year-old son and a several month-old baby. She was at her wits' end dealing with the older child, relating that there is a several year delay in getting professional help to deal with the autism. The child was screaming most of the visit. While we were able to assist this young mother financially, her situation just seemed overwhelming to her, and to our visiting members. We are referring her to the District St. Vincent de Paul staff who have much more expertise in directing this family towards some support agencies. Through the backing of the parish and its members, we are blessed to be able to intervene in situations like this, albeit emotionally challenging.

December 17, 2023 3rd Sunday of Advent Stewards Pray

'Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus." – 1 THESSALONIANS 5:16 – 18

This scripture reading sums up **Stewardship**. "Rejoice always" means place your trust in God; He will provide all that you need. "Pray constantly" means prayer should be a running conversation with God throughout the whole day, every day. "Give thanks in all circumstances" means even in bad situations, thank God. Suffering a little bit helps build empathy for others in similar situations and shows our dependence on God.
