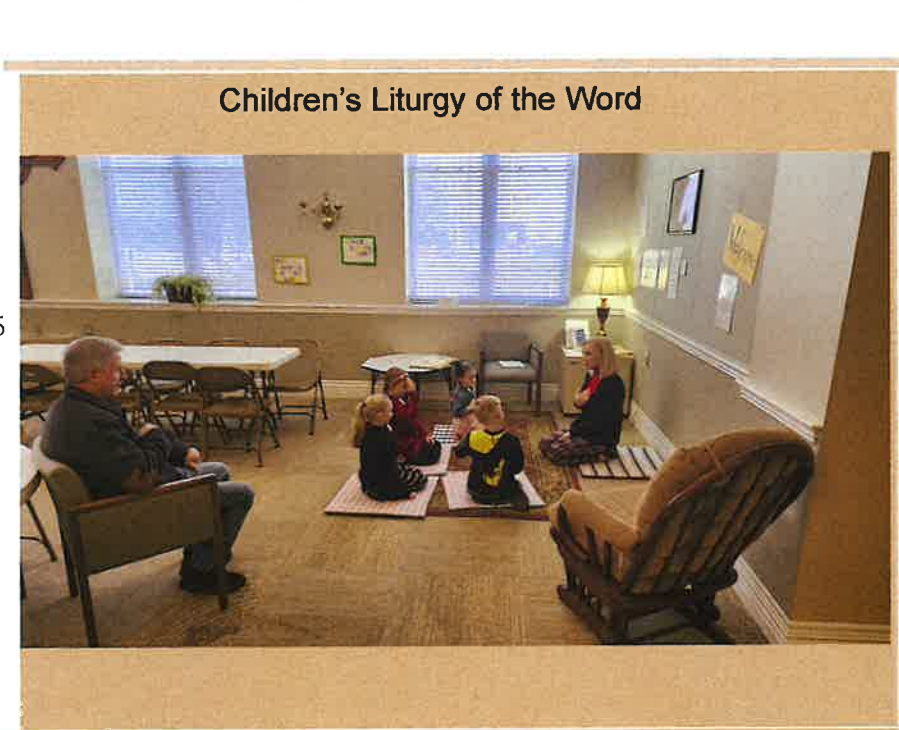

How blessed are we?! To know the risen Christ, and to feel the boundless joy of Easter Sunday in our beautiful Church with our amazing choir and liturgical team... Alleluia! How blessed are we also to have comfortable homes with running water, electricity and working appliances. The Easter season lasts fifty days, so there is still time to share the hope and joy with needy neighbors who possibly aren't as blessed. Neighbors like "J.B." who just moved into a new apartment with her four children. They have nothing. We arranged for beds for the children and paid her CenterPoint deposit so that they can get started; "Mary" who has a disabled husband with a bad heart, and a son who lives independently but for whom she is spokesperson because of his emotional disability. We helped both mother and son with CenterPoint payments to help stave off disconnects. They, along with 11 others requested assistance from our St. Vincent de Paul Society. Your donations help our parish share the light of Easter! Here are a few simple ways that you can live out the eight weeks of Easter: Be joyful. Celebrate as a family. Add a spiritual devotion. Pray daily for our neighbors in need. Give to a charity of your choice. Easter is more than one day. It is a season of joyous Alleluias, and we are truly blessed to experience it.

DIVINE MERCY

Don't forget it is not too late to meet the requirements for Divine Mercy that God wants to give you through His Son. One has to go to Confession within twenty days of Divine Mercy Sunday (April, 7), pray one Our Father, recite the Creed, receive the Eucharist, Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father and say one heartfelt prayer to Jesus. This relieves one from temporal punishment and complete forgiveness of sin.


