ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS

The demand for help remains at a very high level. The District SVdP call center begins accepting calls for our conference at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday morning (after our Tuesday evening meeting). Our 15 slots for the next meeting are routinely filled by 9:00 or 9:30 a.m. that morning! Many of our Neighbors are in financial crisis due to health issues. One such neighbor this week needs neck and back surgery, and is dealing with a 32 year-old son who has cancer and recently suffered a heart attack. He back rent is out of control, but we helped her with CenterPoint so that when she regains housing, she won't have a huge CenterPoint bill to retire before she can get new service. We helped 4 others with CenterPoint and the rest with residential furnishings and rent.

The first Tuesday of the month is also the District SVdP meeting, which our parish hosts in Rager Hall. We learned that the District SVdP Food Pantry (809 N. Lafayette, near the Dearhead Sidewalk Café on Columbia) lost some significant funding, and they have a critical need for canned fruit (peaches, pineapple, and pears), along with peanut butter, and mac and cheese. Whatever you can do for our parish's outreach, and for the District SVdP's food pantry is always greatly appreciated.
