

Though we helped 14 of the fifteen applicants for assistance this week, we had one who apparently sought



our help too late. Late on Friday we received a referral from a Neighbor who expressed an emergency with her rent. We made special efforts to get her a rent check on Monday. When we tried to deliver it to her rental house, no one answered, despite our pre-arrangements to be met there by her husband. When we did reach her by telephone, she explained that her landlord would not accept a partial payment and wanted she and her family out of the home. There are two children. We thank God that there are agencies and safety nets for such families, but it was a big disappointment to us that we were not able to help this unfortunate family. Our prayers go out to her and her family, and to all who support our ministry.
