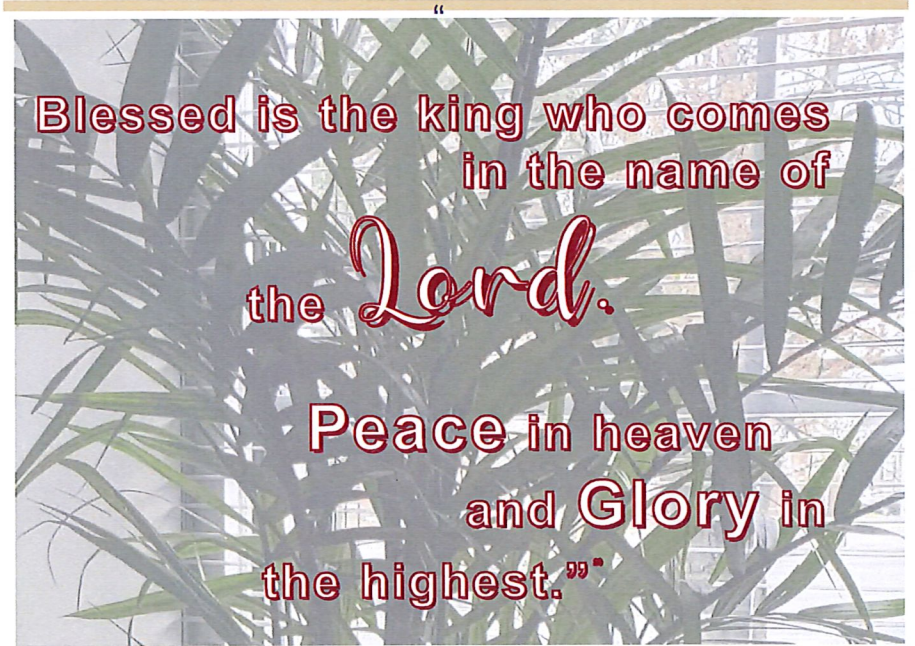

 State Hospital Grounds in Evansville. Meet at 3:30 pm at the parking lot by baseball field off of Lincoln Ave.

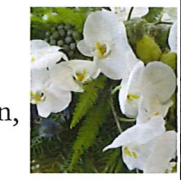


THE CHRISM MASS will be celebrated on **Tuesday, April 12, 5:30 PM CDT, at St. Benedict Cathedral.**
