ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS Your committee's meetings continued through the Easter season. This week, we had calls ranging from simple clothing vouchers, and two furniture vouchers to be used at the St. Vincent de Paul Thrift store, and then 3 CenterPoint and 8 rental assistance requests. Often, we are only in a position to pay enough of a utility bill so as to avoid a shut off. This week, we were able to help one Neighbor get completely caught up with CenterPoint. One mother with new twins needed two cribs. The bed program for "Sleep in Heavenly Peace" is only for children age 3 or above, and the Thrift Store didn't have any cribs available. They don't get them very often. Instead, we helped her retire an old CenterPoint bill so that she can look for new housing, and we provided her with clothing vouchers for herself and three children. Thanks for putting us in a position for the parish to help these people. Sometimes the relief we hear in their voices when they find out we are solving their problems is reward enough in itself.
