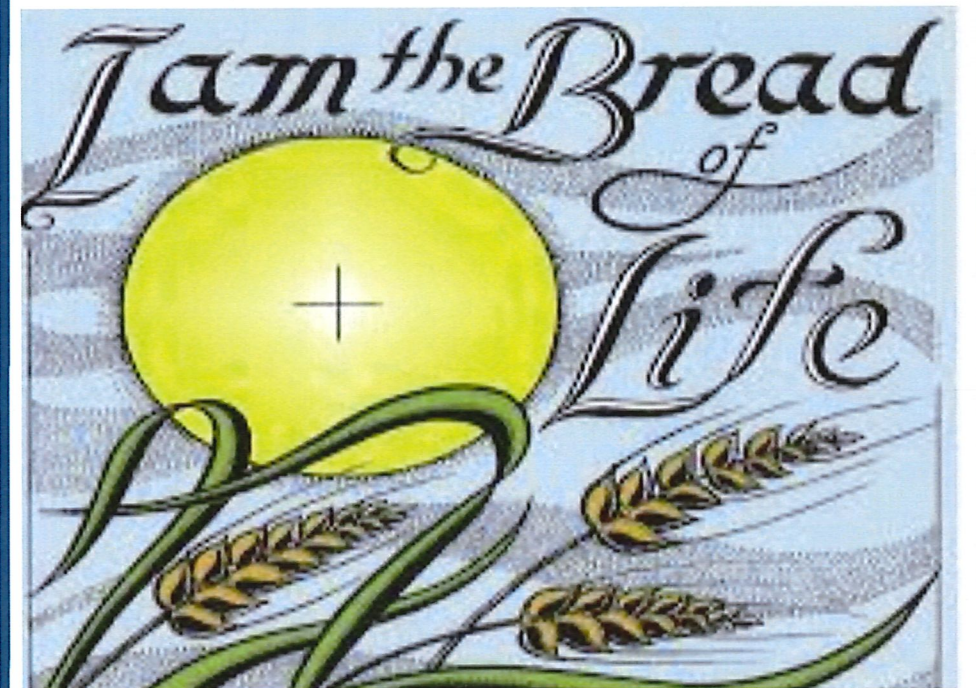
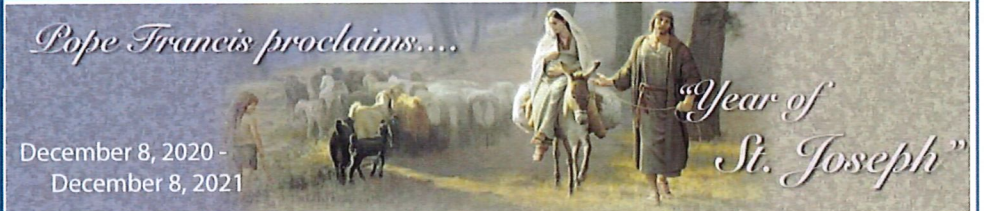

CAJE - Issue Updates:

***Evansville Affordable Housing** - The city should receive final American Rescue Plan spending guidance within two weeks. Update from Mayor Winnecke on the amount he recommends be allocated to the Evansville Affordable Housing Trust Fund (AHTF).

***Dually Diagnosed Child** - We asked Mayor Winnecke to absorb the community-based task force formed in 2019 as a sub-committee of the Mental Health Commission CAJE created in 2016. Answer and additional information in early August.

***Evansville Diversion Center (EDC)** - City & County officials have been in communications with one another and CAJE. Monetary allocations towards the EDC, housed at United Caring Services, will be firmed up soon. Possibly EDC will be running, at least part-time before summer end
***Gun Violence Intervention** - We are awaiting information on when the Gun Violence Task Force will meet again. CAJE co-chair and Safe Neighborhoods Steering Committee member, Pam Decker, has a seat on the Task Force. She will send an update as soon as she learns anything new.
