

This week we again had a full roster of calls to make, but as happens from time to time, several applicants were not possible to reach, though many calls, texts and messages are usually tried. CenterPoint bills remain the focus of many of our calls, and we were able to help several folks avoid shutoff. We had one new resident of Buckner Towers, just across Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd from the church. We helped him meet his first month's rent obligation, and hope he can get settled into his new housing, after being homeless. Two Neighbors needed furniture and we provided them with vouchers to the SVdP Thrift Store where couches are usually priced at \$45. When we ask our Neighbors what their prayer requests may be, sometimes they ask for prayers of thanksgiving for the help they are receiving from Sts. Mary & John Parish. Please know that the people we help appreciate this parish.
