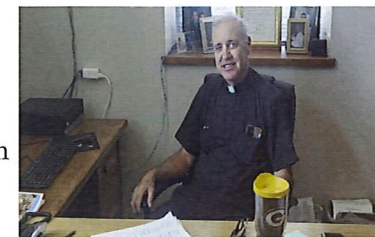

**A note from Fr. Eugene**

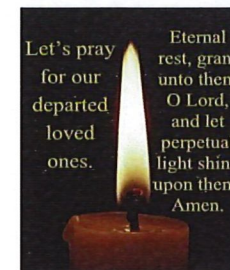
