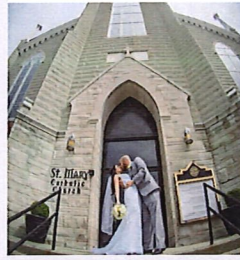

St. Vincent de Paul News...
 "Each week our St. Vincent de Paul committee meets on Tuesday night to review and assist up to 15 of our "Neighbors", primarily with rent, CenterPoint or Water. This week, we were able to help 14 people. Our usual assistance amount that we are able to help with is \$50 per person. This week we did a bit more for three applicants. An example: Susan has fallen behind in her water bill and faced a shutoff. She works, but her husband is home with cancer. Between her own money, and help from Catholic Charities, we were able to provide her with the final \$90.00 and prevent her water from being shut off. Your generosity to our parish St. Vincent de Paul makes a difference in many lives, every week."
