ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS



This week we had 16 referrals for assistance, including 9 households that needed CenterPoint assistance. This continues to be the main issue for the Neighbors in our area... several were totally cut off. We are seeing arrearages in two cases of around \$1,500 and in one case, over \$2,000. We help avoid cut offs where we can, and do assist everyone who asks. We referred four of our Neighbors this week to the District St. Vincent de Paul for special counseling. Noah Werner in that office is especially skilled in knowing what additional services may be available to help these folks—even enlisting some in programs designed to get them out of poverty. The current program meets weekly, and our committee members individually donated the cost of feeding those participants at one of the meetings. On a happier note, we were able to enlist one family for children's beds through the "Sleep in Heavenly Peace" program, and help others with their rent and water bills. Your support lets us engage in this ministry to the poor, and we on the committee are privileged to be your instruments in the effort.

Jesus entrusts us with the responsibility of caring for our neighbors and helping with their everyday material and physical needs. Thank you for all you do.

August 6, 2023 The Transfiguration of the Lord Beloved Stewards

"...then from the cloud came a voice that said, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him.'" - MATTHEW 17:5

When Peter, James and John heard this they immediately fell, prostrate to the ground and they "were very much afraid." We Stewards may respond the same way when we hear God's voice. How many times do you become fearful when invited to participate more fully in the life of the Church? Or, when someone says something negative about the Church, are you afraid to respond? Remember, we too, are beloved sons and daughters of God; Jesus is there to help us, but we need to listen.
