In the peace of this joyous celebration of Christmas, let's ask the King of Kings to come again to our lowly stable where we await him. Let's ask him to heal our hearts wounded by sin; to give hope to those who fight against despair; and to bring to us the light of his face.

May the Lord bless you richly as you welcome the gift of the Son of God.
