### Sts. Mary and John's ST. VINCENT DE PAUL MINISTRY

As we expected, we had a full roster of 15

referrals this week. The mix was a bit different, however, with only one household seeking help with CenterPoint and three with their water bills. None of these had been completely shut off, but were behind in their payments. The bigger emphasis this week was from folks needing furnishings. One mother of three was newly into an apartment and without any furniture. She had recently moved to the area. We helped her with some rent, and submitted an application on her behalf (and another for a different family) to the great folks at "Sleep in Heavenly Peace" who build beds for children. It can take a few weeks for the beds to be ready for delivery, but that group has done wonderful work in this community. We helped three other applicants with vouchers at the Thrift Store where they can shop for furnishings they need,--very often couches--or small appliances. As sometimes happens, one nice man had recently been helped by another parish, and said he no longer needed our help. Your support does
