

This week has shown the growing trend for us to see •new applicants for assistance. We believe this reflects, in part, new housing for needy families being provided. But, many of the persons we serve have fragile economic circumstances, one crisis away from not being able to make ends meet. We have seen illness and job loss as the primary issues. We were able to help 14 of the 16 referrals we had this week, mostly with rent and with CenterPoint shutoff threats.
