The Diocese of Evansville remains committed to the health and safety of the communities and staffs of our 45 parishes, and the students and staffs of our 26 Catholic schools. Diocesan officials continue to track all available data regarding COVID-19, and the current data reflect an overall drop in infections approaching 80 percent.

Because of the trends in the data, and because of the increased availability of COVID-19 vaccines to all age groups except those under 5, COVID-19 policies for parishes, schools and diocesan facilities across the 12 counties of the diocese will become the purview of the administrations of parishes, schools and diocesan facilities, effective immediately.

As a result, the weekly updates based on the state color-code system have ended, and the diocesan guidelines that were related to the color codes no longer apply.
