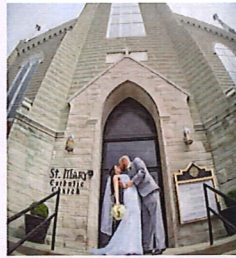

Eucharistic display #3 panels will be here on display in church February 1st through the 6th.

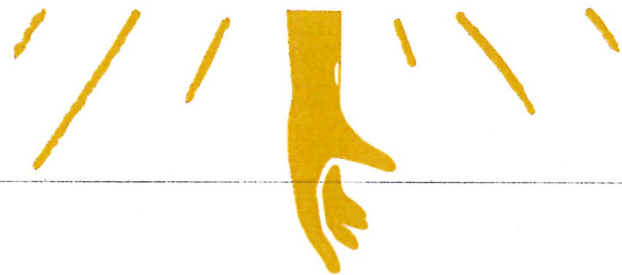
SHOW LOVE...WITH DIAPERS

Stewards Deny Self

“Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.” MATTHEW 5:3

The phrase “poor in spirit” can be confusing. Think of it in this sense – poor in spirit means depending on God’s providence and not depending on our own self-reliance. Being detached from earthy things (power, money, and comfort) and being attached to heavenly things (charity, sacrifice, and mercy). Stewardship is denying ourselves from satisfying our desires and helping others obtain their basic needs.
