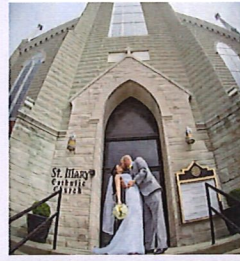

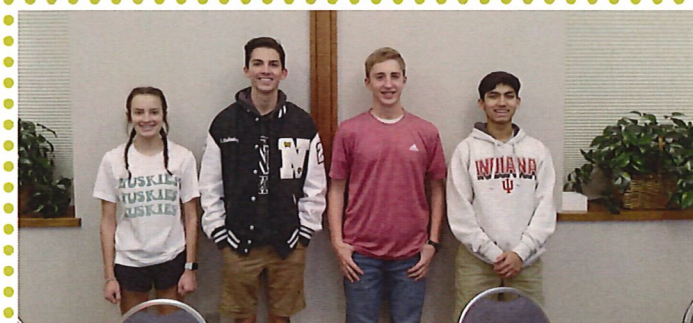
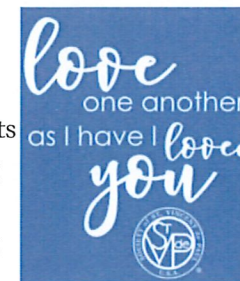

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL...

After not meeting between Christmas and New Year's Day, the committee responded to the requests of 14 households this week. Along with moneys available from a National Catholic Foundation grant and our own funds, **We were able to assist** three families with their CenterPoint bills, and able to avoid shut offs in all three cases. This week was unusual in that **we** had several households request beds. We are noticing that both public and private organizations are helping more and more people into housing, but often with incomplete furnishings. The St. Vincent de Paul thrift store stocks three sizes of manufactured beds, and **We were able to help** pay for an adult sized bed in three households. As to the children, we relay those requests to an organization called "Sleep in Heavenly Peace" where its volunteers build children's beds and deliver them with mattresses and bedding free of charge. **We are blessed to help** so many people in such meaningful ways. Thank you **"We"** for all you do for those in need.
