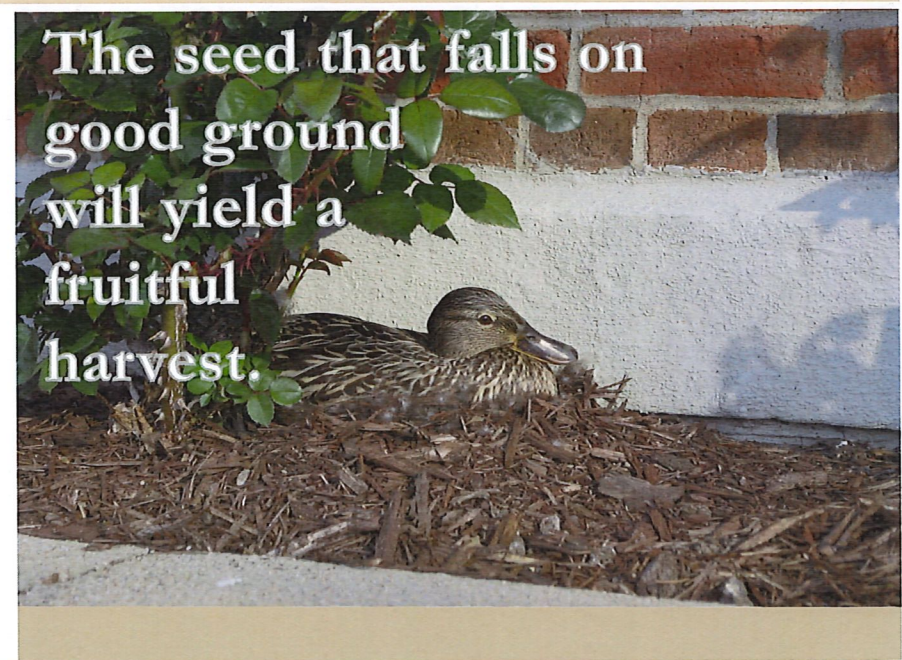

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS

This week we had 15 calls to make, plus two requests for clothing vouchers to be used at the St. Vincent de Paul Thrift store. These vouchers are reimbursed to the store by Sts. Mary & John St. Vincent de Paul for \$5.00 per adult voucher. If that adult has children, each child also get 6 articles of used clothing in their parent's name, so the cost is minimal, and the return is very helpful to them. Of our 15 "regular" referrals, 6 were for CenterPoint and one was for water. With the help of a grant we received from the District St. Vincent de Paul, we were able to bring some people current with their utilities. Two applicants were trying to retire old utility bills so that they could move into new housing, and we assisted them towards that goal. The rest were rent assistance requests, mostly from tenants of the Evansville Housing Authority. The need remains high, and the parish is blessed to assist these worthy Neighbors. The thanks goes to the parish and its support.
