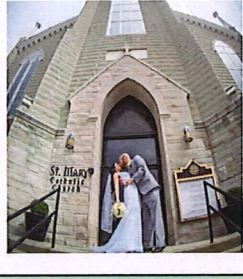

This week, we had our usual 15 calls, with a couple of twists. One person initially needing CenterPoint help had received assistance elsewhere and ended up not needing us this month! We did help 4 others with CenterPoint and 3 with Water. The District St. Vincent de Paul has had the ability to provide us with some additional funds which we can use to augment our resources to help people in crisis, with threatened or actual shut offs on their utilities, or threats of eviction. It is wonderful to hear the gratitude of those families when we can help them get back on track. And, one family had a special problem. The diabetic husband in the family needed some special diabetic shoes, but couldn't afford them because all their income was direct to treatment of his wife's heart issues. Though our St. Vincent committee received this request, we were able to redirect it to Sts. Mary and John's Outreach committee; and the "Christmas Year Around" fund is purchasing these shoes for him. We already have the check and will deliver it to the Deaconess store where the shoes are on order. The parish of Sts. Mary & John does so much good through this outreach. Thanks for your support.

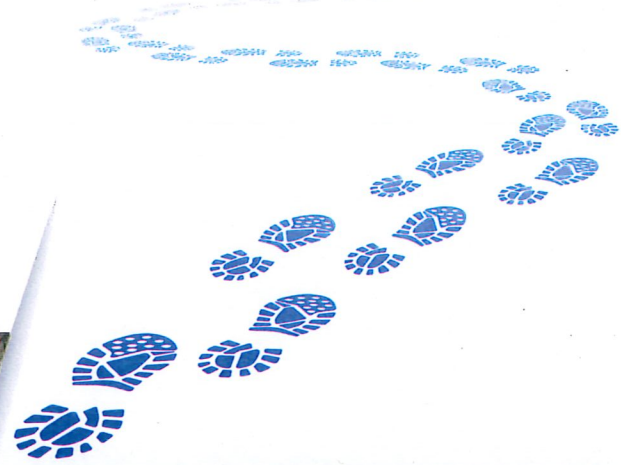
