ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS

Last week we had 16 Neighbors referred to us by the District St. Vincent de Paul call center. Four were requesting CenterPoint help, and 4 needed assistance with their water bills. Most were under threat of cut-off, if not actually cut off. We do our best to avoid a disconnect, or to help them get their utilities restored. If we cannot support all they need, we connect them to other resources where they can get additional moneys. The Township Trustee, the Community Action Program of Evansville (CAPE), Salvation Army, and Catholic Charities are a few examples. We also provided vouchers to be used at the SVdP Thrift Store for three families getting into new housing—often these folks have nothing, so they can began by buying a couch, or kitchen equipment. We learn what prayer requests each of our 16 referrals has, and include them in our Tuesday meeting

This week we had referrals for 15 Neighbors who needed help. Unfortunately, two of them were unreachable. That sometimes happens, and telephone calls, texts and emails (when we have an email address) don't reach the person in need. However, very often we get a follow-up email giving us a better phone number, or other contact information. We helped 3 households with CenterPoint, one with Water, one with a household voucher to spend at the Thrift Store, and a number of rents. Two of us visited a young divorced mother with three children under the age of 10 at her new housing. We had already helped her with a furniture voucher to the Thrift Store the week before, but we have to have a visit to the apartment before we can refer them to "Sleep in Heavenly Peace". That great group builds beds, and then delivers them with mattresses, sheets and pillows. We put them in for a set of bunk beds for the two girls, and a single bed for the 9 year-old special needs boy. Such fulfilling work, made possible by the support of this parish and its members. Thanks so much for your support.

Many of us take our lives for granted. We think we have plenty of time to "repent." Maybe we should live with a little more urgency in making things right with God. This is the difference in living our discipleship out of obligation versus out of love. Obligation implies we do the minimum required. Love implies we want a relationship. God wants us to be with Him in Heaven forever, but He also wants us to live Stewardship and to be in relationship with us right now, while we are on earth Start this second – invite the Lord into your heart.
