The St. Vincent de Paul committee only had 12 referrals (we normally have 15) this week. Things run in cycles, so not so many utility requests (only 3), but many rent assistance requests. Our assigned district includes several public housing facilities. Among them are Schnute Towers Apartments (on West Franklin), Caldwell Homes (far south side), and our across-the-street Neighbors in Kennedy Towers and Buckner Towers. We had a total of 9 requests for rent help including these four housing areas, and we were able to help each one. These Neighbors are always grateful for what Sts. Mary and John parishioners are able to do for them.
