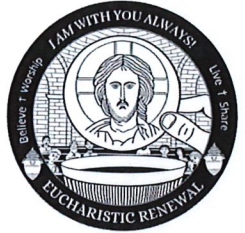

Below is a report previously shared by Pat Fitzsimmons to the Parish Pastoral Council. We are blessed to have her leadership in this parish ministry. Our parish is blessed by each of you for helping make this a vibrant and meaningful ministry. You are in our prayers of gratitude.

APRIL OUTREACH REPORT

Christmas Year Round - This ministry has helped two people obtain bus tickets to relocate or return home. It helped with one client getting overnight lodging.

Food Pantry - This ministry has helped 342 families with food since November 2021. this is an increase of 132 families since last reported. Client visits are slowly increasing. We continue to serve all of Vanderburgh County and clients may visit every 30 days. We have seven new volunteers added to our list of Food Pantry volunteers.

St. Vincent de Paul - This ministry continues its 'visits' by phone. We are not sure when in person visits will resume. They are able to help 15-20 families a week. This group welcomes anyone interested in volunteering or just to attend one of their weekly Tuesday at 6 pm meetings.

Please keep all of these wonderful "disciples" of our parish in your prayers, and if you know one of them please thank them.
