committee was given 16 referrals households—that were seeking help. Nine of these households needed help with a water bill or CenterPoint bill. Interestingly, we had two requests for vouchers to spend at the Thrift Store for Neighbors who had just found housing, and didn't have much in the way of furnishings. We provide them with vouchers to apply towards goods at the Thrift Store. The store has recently undergone a very favorable update of its pricing. By way of example, the amount of our usual voucher is ample to purchase a couch, if any are available. Other household vouchers, two clothing vouchers, and some rent assistances rounded out our week's economic efforts. What this parish does through the donations of its members helps a great number of people. In non-economic terms, we spoke to each Neighbor to learn of their most worrisome issues, and as a group, we add their prayer requests to our group's prayers. We ask that you keep in your prayers the needs of all families we are able to help. Thank you for your generous stewardship to those in need.
