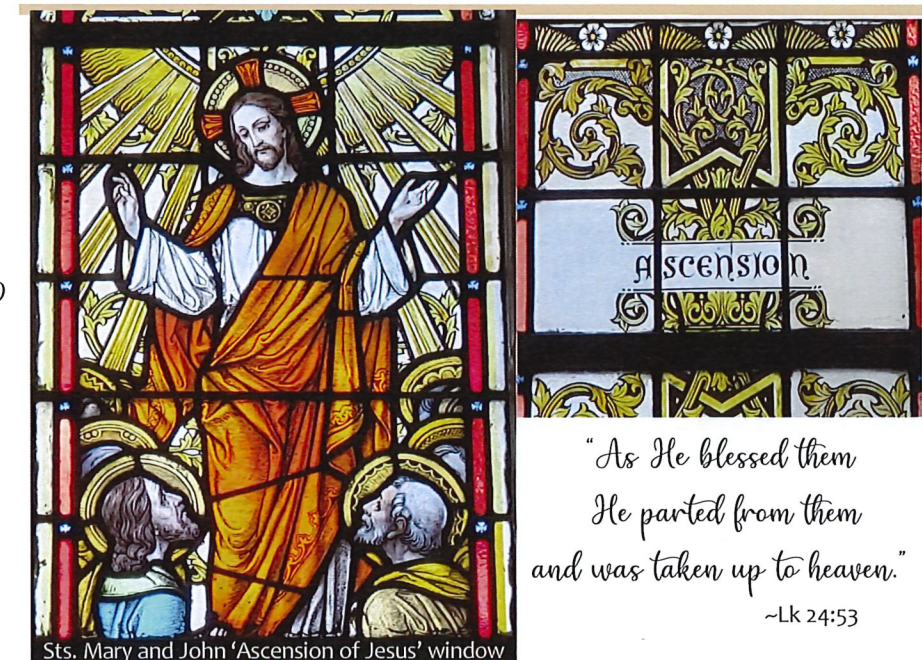

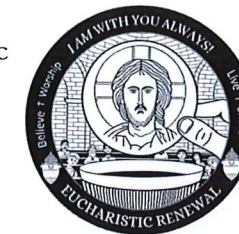
MEMORIAL DAY MASS:
