There is now a meal train that anyone can sign up for (https://mealtrain.com/o07ez8 we only have 6 months planned out, just to see how this works.)

Here's a few quick notes about helping:
Food is provided every Monday and Tuesday.
Monday has 10 college age guys.
Tuesdays would have 5 college age guys.
Drop off on Mondays is strictly 4-5pm.
Drop off on Tuesdays are 4:30-5pm.
Please bring meals in disposable pans.
There are no food allergies at the House.

Give your mind and heart a break

We all need a break sometimes. Maybe it's 5 minutes on the drive to or from work; or using the extra time on a lunch break to get away from the busyness of the day. If it's helpful, there are places online where you can view adoration of the Blessed Sacrament happening live.
