

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

This week we had 16 calls to make. A full 8 households needed help with CenterPoint. One person had actually received help from another agency before we called on her, so we had a rare contact with someone who no longer needed our help. Another man was facing eviction and had a CenterPoint bill over \$1,000. We helped him with some of that bill and referred him forward to one of the workers at the Evansville District St. Vincent de Paul for counseling and exploring other assistance options. One woman's partner was in jail for domestic abuse, and she is pregnant. She has a young child, and she has been relegated to bed rest. We helped her with her rent and similarly referred her for counseling with the District SVdP. We do what we can, and try to provide additional avenues for these folks to address their situations. Your support is always appreciated, and we and they need your prayers. Thank you.
