



30th Sunday in Ordinary Time Humble Stewardship

"...for whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted." LUKE 18:14

Pride and ego are the root causes of most of our sins.

Thinking your time is so valuable or your talent is better than anyone else or your money gives you status is another way of making those things "gods" before God. In Stewardship, pride is the opposite of humility. Remember, all that we have and all that we are is a gift from God. We should be humbled by God's incredible generosity and be grateful for all we have been given. Ultimately, gratitude leads us to humility.
