After saving enough money from a job she recently got, she was able to make a downpayment on a rental home. They now had a home but it was completely empty. We aren't usually able to help with furniture but, as God works in our lives, someone who was moving needed to find a home for her furniture, someone else had a truck and willing grandsons to offer muscle, and all came together to help a family in need not only have a house but also a home! Here is her story: " I don't see my life as difficult. I am blessed. For 6 months, we were without a home. Now, we finally have our own home. God is great. He helped us through our struggles. We may not have everything but we have food in our bellies, a roof over our head and my beautiful children. I am blessed." And so are all of us.
