



BE AWARE OF TEXT AND EMAIL SCAMS

It was brought to our attention that a variation of a text message/email scam is again happening in our Diocese. The scammer identified themselves as a priest and requested help. Some points to keep in mind to better help you protect yourself:

1. Never give out information over the phone unless you are absolutely sure that you truly are speaking with whom they

- represent themselves as.

 2. If a request for funds, banking changes, or other sensitive information is sent to you, you should verify that the sender is actually someone with which you do business.
- 3. There is NO legitimate reason for someone to ask you to buy gift cards and send them pictures of the gift cards.
- 4. If the email, text, or phone call claims to be from someone at your parish, church, school, or etc., verify that it really did come from them by a DIFFERENT method from the original contact.

 5. Verify what email address the email actually came from, don't rely on just that the name looks correct.
