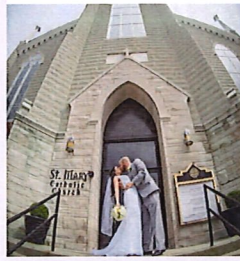

BE AWARE OF TEXT AND EMAIL SCAMS

It was brought to our attention that a variation of a text message/email scam is again happening in our Diocese. The scammer identified themselves as a priest and requested help. Some points to keep in mind to better help you protect yourself:

1. Never give out information over the phone unless you are absolutely sure that you truly are speaking with whom they represent themselves as.
2. If a request for funds, banking changes, or other sensitive information is sent to you, you should verify that the sender is actually someone with which you do business.
3. There is NO legitimate reason for someone to ask you to buy gift cards and send them pictures of the gift cards.
4. If the email, text, or phone call claims to be from someone at your parish, church, school, or etc., verify that it really did come from them by a DIFFERENT method from the original contact.
5. Verify what email address the email actually came from, don't rely on just that the name looks correct.
