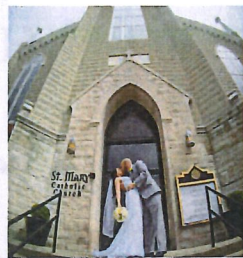

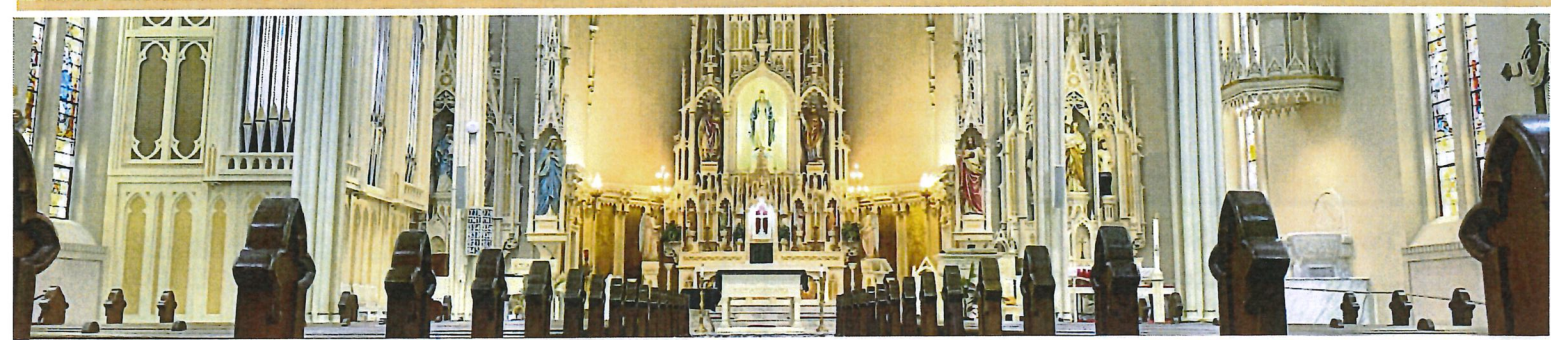

Since this family of six moved to Evansville about a year ago the father had a stroke. Recently the mother lost her job when she took off work for their daughter's medical emergency. Her husband called to let them know but it was too late. She will receive payment for her last week and a weeks vacation pay but that has not happened yet. She is seeking employment and has had an interview with a company that has a 6 week process so it won't be soon enough to get them through to another paycheck. It is really hard to ask for help the first time.

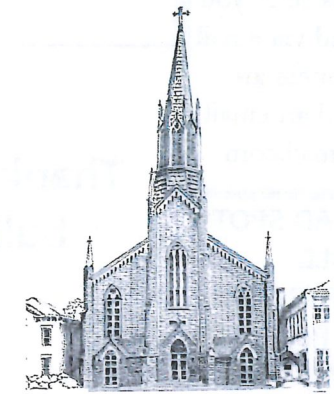
