

There is always something new under the sun.

This week we had 12 calls: four requests for

assistance with CenterPoint, two with water, four with rent, and one person needed a store voucher for her apartment, and a clothing voucher for herself. Our twelfth request was something quite new to us. The neighbor in question was staying at a shelter, after a period of homelessness. Her worldly possessions, including a former employer's portable computer she needed to return, was in storage. Despite not having paid her storage bill, she needed access to the storage unit to get her things, return the computer, and start a new job this week. The problem was that her need was made known to us on the Thursday before the Labor Day Weekend, and the storage company's main office (for payment) was in Bloomington. That same day, one of our volunteers took the check to the post office where a two-day delivery was arranged with tracking. The check arrived Saturday, and over the weekend we were able to confirm to the Neighbor that she could get into her storage unit to meet all her deadlines. She was almost in tears in gratitude. Thanks to the generosity of our parish, and the extra effort of one of our Sts. Mary and John conference members, we were able to help facilitate someone on to her new job and hopefully, self-sufficiency.
