

It is apparent that so many of our "neighbors" are managing very close to the edge financially, and that one unanticipated expense can knock them off their economic track. In one instance, a child's bad auto accident with her being treated in Indianapolis had our client out of work, and falling behind in her rent. We assisted her with \$100. Another \$100 assistance was provided to a neighbor who had fallen behind in her CenterPoint utility bill due to a death of her sister, forcing her to pay for funeral expenses. These two, along with another person in substantial arrears were referred to Noah Werner at the SVdP District offices. Noah is particularly skilled at counselling people in significant straights and referring them to other sources of help. Thanks to everyone in the parish who supports our outreach mission.
