

#### ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS...

Thanks to those who especially remember our Sts. Mary & John outreach ministries, including our St. Vincent de Paul conference, at Christmas time. Both outreach groups have almost no overhead. This week was a rent "cycle" with most of our 16 Neighbors requesting assistance in keeping a roof over their heads. As parishioners, you are likely aware that we have over 5 Evansville Housing Authority properties in our area of coverage. Most closely, we are across the street from Kennedy and Buckner Towers. But, our district extends south to the levy (Caldwell Homes) and west to Schnute Apartments on West Franklin. If the Neighbors in those facilities have any significant income, they generally pay around 30% of that for rent. Even though most occupants are on Section 8 housing, they are expected to pay some rent (minimum \$50 per month), and often we assist with that. Three Water and three CenterPoint referrals rounded our assignments for the week. We have two more active weeks' worth of referrals before the end of the year. Our Neighbors greatly appreciate all this parish does for them.
