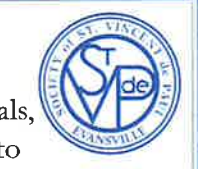

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS...



Each week brings new challenges and new rewards. This week, of our 15 referrals, 9 were for CenterPoint help. Our goal is to help avoid shut-offs whenever possible, and if we can't do it on our own, then to give the Neighbor in question directions to other organizations who can help. With CenterPoint, we have had access to their payment website which permits us to pledge our payments online the same evening we meet and decide how much we can pay. The actual payment is mailed to Houston TX, CenterPoint's home office Wednesday morning, but it can take a week or more to get there and be processed. During CP's computer change-over, that system is undergoing change too, and we aren't able to notify CenterPoint of our intended payment. We have had to clearly inform the affected neighbors that there could be up to a week from our mailing and CenterPoint's receipt. The challenges faced by our Neighbors are many, and varied. We keep them in our prayers and ask that you do as well.

Thank you for your donations. You make it possible to help those in need who reach out to us for help.

PANERA BREAD MINISTRY
