St. Vincent de Paul Update

We have been chugging along this summer with full rosters of Neighbors. Sometimes other conferences receive a request for assistance, but the Neighbor is actually in our district. We can end



up 16-18 calls when those are redirected to us, more than our intended 15 per week. CenterPoint remains the main concern for our clients, a full 9 of the referrals this week. Besides doing what we can, we counsel the Neighbor on other sources of funding. CenterPoint has a program administered through the Salvation Army which offers one-time utility bill forgiveness up to a certain amount, which is very generous. So, between our conference, this CenterPoint program, the Trustee, and possibly CAPE, we try to avoid cut offs. There is so much need out there, that any contributions our fellow parishioners make are put to immediate and critical use. God bless. Thank you for all you do for those in need in our community.

Anointing of the Sick

We offer the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick monthly the first full weekend of each month after all Masses. The sacrament is administered by a priest to a person suffering from a serious illness, preparing for surgery, in danger of death or frail due to advanced age. The sacrament aims to strengthen the ill, offering peace, courage, and spiritual healing. It can also provide forgiveness of sins if the person cannot confess.
