ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS...

Greetings fellow parishioners. This week we helped 14 Neighbors, many with CenterPoint, some with water, some with rent, and two who needed vouchers. As organizers and the city work to house the homeless, and those coming from hard circumstances, we are seeing persons who have a new place to live, without any possessions. The very reasonable prices at the St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store make it possible for us to help them acquire furnishings. Our budget, thanks to you, permits us to give these Neighbors a \$75.00 furniture voucher with sufficient buying power to get a used couch. This fulfills the need for a bed and an apartment furnishing all in one. The Thrift store is constrained to handle only new beds, but if you have a gently used bed you want to donate, call Lee at the office and let her know. We may have someone who could take it off your hands. Please keep up your support, it goes a long way.
