**ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS...**



There is an inspirational quote that says: "You didn't wake up today to be mediocre". We all pray to be galvanized to reach out to do the Lord's work. Members of this parish perform that work in many ways: choir, Eucharistic ministers, hospitality, food pantry, parish council, and so many other ways. If you are looking for an enriching activity, we have an active St. Vincent de Paul group that meets weekly for an hour or so beginning at 5 o'clock on Tuesday nights to report on the calls made by the members on Monday or Tuesday before the meeting. We pray, we discuss the 15 or so Neighbors who have asked for help, and make decisions on how much we can help them. Each Neighbor is asked for their prayer needs, and those are included in our prayers. If you think you might like to join this ministry, please let Lee know, or just show up at 5:00 p.m. at the Ministry Center some Tuesday.

In the past two weeks, we have had a full roster of 15 calls each week. While we had eight requests for assistance with CenterPoint the last week in June, there weren't any this week. CenterPoint is transitioning to a new computer system and new account numbers, and during that time, announced it wouldn't be shutting off any service until the new system is up and running. One mother with two children was at risk of having her water cut off, and we were able to help her avoid that. Another was so far behind on her water that it had been shut off. We contributed towards helping her catch up, and referred her to other organizations who may also help. Our resources are limited, so anything that you, the parishioners, can contribute is greatly appreciated. God bless. We operate by your donations. God bless.
