

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL UPDATE... Once a month, the president of our SVdP conference attends a meeting of the District officers, and the presidents of the other 18 conferences. While it is not a competition, we do get statistics on the year-to-date activity of the various conferences. Our St. Vincent de Paul conference here at Sts. Mary and John parish has helped 557 households in the 8 months since 10/1/24 (the start of our fiscal year). Only All Saints Conference has helped more households, with 579. Good Shepherd and Annunciation are also above 500 for this same period. Other conferences have assisted with more money than we have access to, but the level of activity by the 19 St. Vincent de Paul Conferences in our District to assist the less fortunate is very impactful.

All of this shows the dimension of the need out there. We attended to 31 Neighbors in the last two weeks, with CenterPoint and rent continuing as the greatest needs. We use the support of this parish and grants to do this. The parish is a very big portion of this, and we and our Neighbors thank you.
