

#### ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS... This week we had our capacity of 15

referrals. One of our Neighbors who

needed assistance with her rent lives in an assisted living facility. However, she is in the hospital now, and will be in a rehab facility before she can return to her housing unit. We helped her with her rent, and sent the check to her landlord at the facility. Normally we send a rent check to the Neighbor, but payable to the landlord. That way, the Neighbor knows when the rent was paid. There were 6 others whom we helped with rent, four with their CenterPoint bills, two with water, and the others with furniture vouchers for the Thrift Store. We accept referrals beginning on Wednesday morning. As of the time this is being written, early on Wednesday afternoon, we already have 10 new requests for help by the time we have our Tuesday evening meeting. The need exceeds our capacity in manpower and finances, but we feel we are doing the Lord's work when we help with what we have. Thank you for making this possible.
