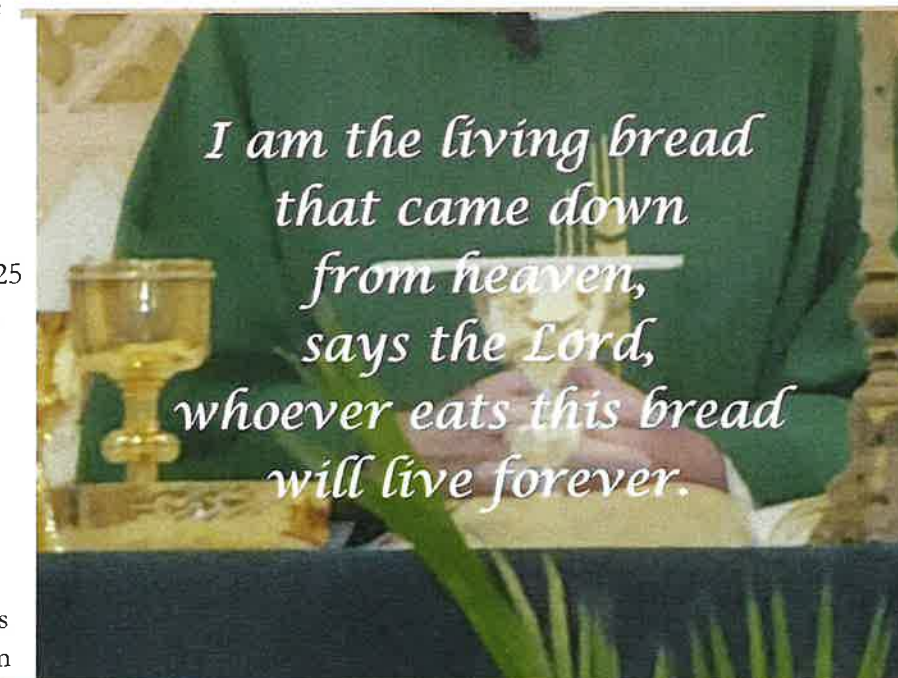

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS...

This week, in working with 15 neighbors (5 CenterPoint, one water, along with rents and furnishings requests), we passed a milestone. St. Vincent de Paul started in Evansville with Assumption Church in 1882. St. Mary's Parish began its St. Vincent de Paul outreach January 4, 1940, and was formally recognized by the Paris office of St. Vincent de Paul on April 30, 1956 when we received what is called our "Aggregation". At some point, in order to maintain confidentiality for those whom we serve, your Sts. Mary & John Conference began assigning numbers to the records we keep on those we help. This past week, we surpassed 15,000 instances of help since that numbering system has been in place. The parish should be proud that it has supported this ministry for more than 80 years.

Oh, and about that Spanish speaking Neighbor we mentioned in last week's bulletin, we did call on her. Her landlord happened to be present, and this very helpful and kind man was fluent in both English and Spanish and we got through the visit in fine fashion. We are assisting her with a bed large enough for her and her daughter.

On Thursday, two of our volunteers went the extra step of picking up the bed from the SVdP Thrift Store and delivering it to the Neighbor, as she had no other way to transport it to her residence. God bless everyone for their participation in these activities, whether personal or financial or prayer.
