ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS...

We contacted or visited 15 households this week. CenterPoint and rents were the principle needs for our Neighbors. We believe we reported in the past on a Neighbor who had moved from Louisville to our area, and then had his boys join him, now ages 13 and younger. They had been in a bad situation gang-wise in Louisville, and actually witnessed their mother being shot. After a couple of years here, the boys insisted they wanted to return to their now-recovered mother in Louisville. To his dismay, he has reported that both boys are now in juvenile custody as a result of possession of marijuana, and on the case of the older child, a gun in a situation where someone was killed. This Neighbor has some health issues, but despite them, is returning to work next week. We helped him get caught up in his rent until he can get his first paycheck. Despite these terrible things, his faith remains high, and he asked prayers for his boys and for his health. We are hopeful that with his return to work, he won't need to ask for help going forward. Bless all of you for your support.
