ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS...



After our Tuesday evening meeting when we discuss the Neighbors who were included in the week's set of referrals, we pledge and pay the water bills and CenterPoint bills which have come up, and write checks for rent help. Then, Wednesday, the Call Center for St. Vincent de Paul begins accepting calls for the following week. For the last several months, we have our capacity number of 15 referrals by noon, just a few hours after the phone lines are open. This week we had ten households with CenterPoint requests, one water request and several rental requests. One grandmother had her husband in a nursing home recovering from a stroke, and a son in a nursing home dealing with cancer. Yet, she had several grandchildren she was raising, and a couple of foster children. Such generosity never fails to inspire, and to make us thankful for our own more stable lives. This grandmother was most grateful for the CenterPoint help we were able to provide, and asked for prayers for all who made our help possible.
