

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS...

This week we worked with 16 households, mostly rent help.
Antidotally, we appear to see the continuing trend for people to get into



housing. We are helping folks who have gained housing, but need furnishings. Beds are a basic, but many people also need dressers, tables and chairs, and other basic furnishings. The St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store has very reasonable standard pricing, and often our assistance consists of a furniture voucher to the Thrift Store, which then bills us on a monthly basis. The Evansville Housing Authority operate most of the low-income public housing in our district of coverage. Rents there vary from minimal (\$50 per month) to significantly higher for persons with income. A rule of thumb in that case is to charge about one-third of their monthly income. Often, such Neighbors are one paycheck (or disability/social security check) away from financial straits. That's where we come in, and try to help those folks weather their hopefully temporary situations. This parish very actively helps up to 15-16 Neighbors a week, for which they are very grateful.

FOOD PANTRY NEWS

Thank you for the support of our parish Food Pantry. In the month of May we served 116 households which accounted for 196 people.


