Qualified Charitable Distributions to Sts. Mary and John Parish

If you are over 70 1/2, consider making charitable donations from your IRA using a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). You can transfer up to \$100,000 per year to an eligible charity. While a QCD does not generate a charitable deduction, you do not have to report the income. Talk with your tax advisor to ensure you are maximizing the tax benefit of any donation.

Albion Fellows Bacon Center, on Thursday,

June 6th, suffered an overnight fire in our Emergency Shelter. Shelter residents were safely relocated but Albion's services continued 24/7 for victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking, and stalking. While we are still assessing and beginning restoration efforts, we need your congregation's help. During the fire, smoke and water damaged/destroyed our pantry with food, snacks, and bottled drinks for our guests. The shelf stable goods fed our guests in shelter, support groups, and on crisis calls throughout the year. Can you help Albion stock the shelves.

In 2023, the following individuals took advantage of the programs and services provided by Albion Fellows Bacon Center:

- provided 7,732 nights of safe shelter to 171 adults, 133 children and 36 pets. (stays up to 60 days)
- Calls to our two 24-hour crisis lines totaled 9,664.
- Mobile Advocacy Program assisted 2,258 primary and secondary clients throughout eleven-counties.
