We listen to the newcomers to our area in need of beds for her three children (we perform the intake inspection for, and then sign them up with Sleep in Heavenly Peace).

We listen to the mother who was staying with friends until their basement flooded and they lost all their belongings.

We listen to all of them, we help them where we can and we pray for them at each meeting.
