

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL NEWS...

This week we worked with 15 Neighbors in need. The emphasis was on rent, with 9 persons needing help with their rent bills. Some of them were working or starting jobs, which is a very good sign. Once folks get into their jobs, they gradually are able to make it on their own, and we see them less often, and sometimes not at all. These are hopeful signs. We are mindful of the admonition that "the poor will always be with us". Pope Francis was particularly devoted to out-reach to the poor and the marginalized, and with all the discussions of his legacy, we are very aware and thankful for this opportunity to be of help to our Neighbors in need. Thanks for all you do to support this parish outreach.



St. Mary Grotto

Our Lady of Lourdes is a Roman Catholic title of the Blessed Virgin Mary venerated in honor of the Marian apparitions that allegedly occurred in Lourdes, France. On the feast of the Annunciation of the Virgin Mary on March 25th, the Lady at last proclaimed her identity to Bernadette, saying "I am the Immaculate Conception". The solemnity of Mary's Immaculate Conception is celebrated on December 8 and honors the conception of Mary in the womb of her mother, St. Anne, without original sin. The doctrine of the Immaculate Conception had been proclaimed only a few years before, in 1854.



As we enter into May, a month dedicated to Mary, Fr. Eugene would like to present in greater detail the Virgin Mary appearing to St. Bernadette at Lourdes, France and the connection to our Grotto. Please join Fr. Eugene in church for this presentation on either of these dates...
