

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

Tuesday, your SVdP conference here at Sts. Mary & John parish had 16 referrals for Neighbors in need of help. Most were for assistance with rent. We have a mixture of renters—some live in



Evansville Housing Authority facilities, such as Kennedy Towers and Buckner Towers. Their rent is figured on a sliding scale, depending upon their income. It varies from a minimum of \$50 per month, up to 1/3 of their monthly income. Frequently, that monthly income is derived from Social Security Disability benefits, or in some cases, actual wages if the tenant is able to perform some work. Other renters pay non-governmental landlords. More often than not, those tenants pay utilities as well. As you might expect, those leases are much higher than the EHA units.

We were able to help one tenant get his power restored, after working with CenterPoint to straighten out some confusion on his bill, and paying the amount needed to have CP resume service. We are seeing more and more neighbors who want vouchers to be spent at the SVdP Thrift store for furniture and/or appliances. It is clear that the agencies in town are working to move the homeless into some kinds of housing. We help these Neighbors furnish their units through the Thrift Store. These are just a few examples of how the support we receive from the parishioners here at Sts. Mary & John Parish is put into action through your SVdP outreach ministry.
