On Tuesday, we called upon 15 Neighbors in need. CenterPoint was the main financial need for 7 clients. As usual, to the extent we had the resources, we sought to avoid shut off by our paying the disconnect fee, or enough of it so that other sources could make up the difference. Often, we team up with the Township Trustee, Catholic Charities, and the Salvation Army. We had one particularly dire situation with a homeless person who is living in her car. She needed help with a storage locker fee where she is keeping her possessions until she can regain employment (job pending) and housing. We are trying to get her current on her storage locker fee, and put her in touch with agencies who can assist her with finding an apartment. The needs for some people are so great! Thank you for an especially generous outreach collection at mass recently. Please pray for those whom we try to help.

In 2018, Pope Francis established the Monday after the Solemnity of Pentecost, the day on which the Church was born, as the date for this memorial. May 24- Mary Help of Christians (a good day to pray for our brothers and sister around the world)
